

ScanDir Version 1.3.5

Use ScanDir to find files on your computer based on multiple selection criteria. The results of the Scan operation are shown in an item-list.

The content of the item-list can be printed or exported to a text file. Files in the item-list can be Viewed, Opened, Renamed, Deleted, Moved, Copied, Joined, Split or Printed. Select Help on the main menu or press F1 for more information.

Pre-requisites

ScanDir 1.3.5 has been tested with Windows 10 but requires at least Windows Vista.

Installation

windows installer: run scandir135_install.exe;

Depending on your Windows version, the 32-bit or 64-bit version of ScanDir will be installed.

scandir135_install.exe may generate additional warning messages, see Online Help:

portable format: extract files from scandir135.zip;

scandir135.zip contains both 32-bit and 64-bit executables of ScanDir. The 64-bit version requires a 64-bit Windows operating system.

The 32-bit version of ScanDir runs on Windows 32-bit and 64-bit operating systems.
